## WIAC 2012 Arts Scholarship Application Overview

The Whidbey Island Arts Council is pleased to offer the 2012 Arts scholarship awards opportunity to graduating high school students on Whidbey. Please read through this application packet, provide the information requested and send the materials to scholarship project coordinator (See page 5.)

**WHAT:** \$1,000 art scholarship award sent to your new school/college.

**WHO:** The applicant must be a resident of Whidbey Island and a graduating senior who intends to pursue post-secondary education with a major in the visual, literary or performing arts.

**HOW:** Apply to give a personal presentation of your work: performance, visual or literary. Demonstrate academic merit and financial need. A completed scholarship application packet includes:

1. A resumé of your school and community activities; honors and awards received; work experiences. Maximum 1 page, double spaced.
2. Personal information. (See page 2.)
3. Three letters of recommendation. Maximum 1 page each, double spaced. (See page 4.)
4. A statement of your education and professional goals. Maximum 1/2 page, double spaced.
5. Completed financial statement signed by a parent. (See page 3.)
6. Your high school transcript.
7. Examples of your work. (Details on page 5.)
8. When all the above is received, applicants will be scheduled for a 20-minute presentation & interview which will include:
  - a. Examples of visual or literary work; a musical, theatrical or dance performance.
  - b. An interview with a panel of judges.

**WHEN:**

1. Application deadline: your packets must be mailed and postmarked or hand delivered no later than **March 10, 2012** to Barbara Graham (See page 5.)
2. Presentations are scheduled T.B.A
