DEADLINE: July 30, 2012

Qualifications: Artists applying for Visual Arts Grants...

- Must have a dedicated need for the grant as part of either ongoing or ensuing work. This need could be as varied as research, documentation, equipment or materials, skills enhancement through workshops, or studio upgrades.
- Must produce original work.
- Must live on Whidbey Island.
- May not use the funds for work that accrues academic credit.

Ineligible Artists: Those serving on the Whidbey Island Arts Council Board and their family members.

Submission Materials: Submit three (3) copies of the following:

- A letter stating that you meet all the qualifications for artists and includes your contact information (name, mailing address, phone numbers, email)
- Biography of the artist (limit to 200 words)
- Project Description (limit to 200 words) including the medium of the project and your primary medium.
- For Non-Film/Video Artists: Three (3) to eight (8) images of your work printed in color. For each image include
 - Title
 - Medium or materials
 - Dimensions
 - Date of completion
- For Film/Video Artists: Three (3) to eight (8) DVDs with descriptive narrative.
