Application Process
applications processed April 1, October 1, annually

This grant is designed to encourage professional artists by providing funds for needs such as research, documentation, equipment or materials, skills enhancement through workshops, or studio upgrades. We are dedicated to serving those in financial need.

Qualifications: Artists applying for *Visual Arts Grants*...

- Must produce original work.
- Must live on Whidbey Island.
- May not use the funds for work that accrues academic credit.

Ineligible Artists: Those serving on the Whidbey Island Arts Council Board and their family members.

Submission Materials: Submit the following:

- **A letter** stating that you meet all the qualifications for artists and include your contact information (name, mailing address, phone numbers, email) and annual income. Please include whether or not you volunteer in the community. This includes service to the community not related to the arts.
- **Biography** of the artist (limit to 200 words)
- **Project Description** (limit to 200 words) including the medium of the project and your primary medium.
- **For Non-Film/Video Artists:** Three (3) to eight (8) images (2 MB) of your work. **Submit digitally.** For each image include
 - Title
 - Medium or materials
 - Dimensions
 - Date of completion
- **For Film/Video Artists:** Three (3) to eight (8) DVDs with descriptive narrative.
